

Decision Summary – April 1 to June 30, 2017

The following establishments requested a hearing before the Licensing Appeal Tribunal regarding compliance issues and received suspensions of 14 days or more or revocations. Establishment	Infraction	Sanction
Area One, Markham	Permitted drunkenness; overcrowding; failure to clear signs of service	30 days

Other Suspensions/Revocations

Suspensions of 14 days or more and revocations where the licensee did not request a hearing before the Licence Appeal Tribunal.

Establishment	Infraction	Sanction
Asif's, Timmins	Permitted narcotics on premises; licensee failed to ensure control of premise was maintained	14 days
Cargo KTV, Toronto	Permitted drunkenness	17 days
Fancy	Overcrowding; non-compliance with "Fire Protection and Prevention Act"	15 days
