Race 4, Turf, clear. Reviewed the run into far turn, #1, Irish Teardrop, Skye Chernetz, 7th, appears to check. There was only one view, the backtower shot, was inconclusive as to the space on the inside for the #1 and the #4, Treasure Finder, ridden by J. Alderson, 6th on the outside. We spoke with both riders, Ms. Chernetz felt he made it tight for her and Mr. Alderson thought he had pressure from the outside. The horses involved did not reflect the top four in the order of finish.

Race 5, #2 Slovenia was off a step slow, Stewards' inquiry, #5 Connors Senorita, R. Hernandez, 2nd, and #2 Slovenia, J. Campbell, 3rd, at the top of the stretch. Upon review, front tower and upper pan angles, the #5 does come in, as #2 is on the rail. #2 may go out slightly and J. Campbell appears to check. After speaking with both riders, J. Campbell felt his horse was a little shy on the inside and R. Hernandez attested he did leave room. There was no change made to the order of finish.
