Race 5 - #7 "Samurai Queen" ridden by Luis Contreras was unruly in the gate and subsequently a Vet Scratch.

Race 6 – Stewards Inquiry regarding #5 “La Vie En Rose” ridden by Eurico Da Silva, #6 “Sugar Me Sweet” ridden by Daisuke Fukumoto, #7 “Treasure Finder” ridden by Jesse Campbell for interference at the top of the stretch. Eurico said the #6 horse came out in front of him and put him in a bad spot, was lucky not to catch heels. Jesse said #6 came out and forced the #5 onto him, had to steady. Daisuke said his horse went out at the top of the stretch but felt he was clear. After review we disqualified #6 “Sugar Me Sweet” from third position and placed it sixth behind #5 “La Vie En Rose”
