10:00 – Received notice from the vets office that in todays' fifth race #4 "Typically" will not run on Lasix as denoted in the program.

Film Reviews:

Review of Sunday September 16, race 2 with Jesse Campbell, Emma Jayne-Wilson and Jerome Lermyte. Emma said Jesse came up to my inside then in front of me, caught his heel and had to check. My horse came on to be third. Jerome said the video speaks for itself, he came out on us. Jesse said he was looking for room and was going to take the hole between Emma and Rafael but his horse reacted stronger than I expected. Thought I would be ok if I just shaved Rafael but she overreacted on me. After discussion it was decided a three day riding suspension be issued to Jesse for the incident.

Urging issues in the Natalma Stakes with Skye Chernetz and Jerome Lermyte. Skye had one strike that was over the shoulder as did Jerome. Both have not had a violation for more than one year, warnings were issued.

Race 2 on Wednesday September 19, involving Emma Jayne-Wilson and Eurico Da Silva. Eurico said she was coming out through the lane and my horse was picking her up with every stride until she came out hard at the end, on heels, had to check stopping my momentum. Emma said her horse was getting out with her steadily but thought I would be ok until the last part when Eurico

got to me then she really went out. I was doing what I could to keep straight. After discussion it was decided that Emma be levied a three day riding suspension.
