Report on day's events:

(Accidents, claims, fines and/or suspensions, objections and/or disqualifications, refunds and any other pertinent incidents)

Office:

- Emergency lights and siren are functioning properly after the one week hiatus in racing.
- Reviewed safety regulations and protocols with management relating to public and participant safety for the parade horses and starting gate.
- Review with driver Nick Boyd from 8 September race 8 regarding his urging of ROCKET GAL in the stretch; Mr. Boyd was adjudged guilty of violating AGCO rules 22.23.01 (b) (excessive) and 22.23.03 (a, b & c) (above head, beyond 90° relative to the track and outside the confines of the sulky) and assessed a driving suspension of three day (to be served 7-9 October, inclusive) and a monetary penalty of \$200 (SB 50393).
- Review with driver Nick Boyd from 8 September race 9 regarding AGCO rule 22.05.01 (k) (failure to set or maintain a pace comparable to class); the explanation of Mr. Boyd was partially accepted and no penalty was assessed.

Races:

1. Driver of #1 MAGNIFY BLISS, Jason Woodward, will attend the Judge's office for a review of his urging in the stretch relative to AGCO rules 22.23.03 (a & b) (above head and beyond 90° relative to the track). Clear.
2. Reviewed possible interference after the ¾ mile pole between #2 EATAAMCLASSICFOX (Clayton Graham) who finished 5th and #3 BLUE

MASERATI (Rodney Hughes) who finished 3rd; #2 appears to push #3 three wide, Mr. Graham stated he was not “bothered very much” while Mr. Hughes stated his horse was green (four lifetime starts) and beared out; no placing necessary; Mr. Hughes cautioned regarding causing interference and having control of his horse, no penalty. Clear.

7. Inquiry on #2 HONOR ABOVE ALL (Keith Jones) after the $\frac{3}{4}$ mile pole concerning AGCO rule 18.08.02 (leaving the course), #2 hit two consecutive pylons but did not leave the course, no violations. Clear.
8. Breathalyzer retest. Clear.
9. Inquiry on #3 CASIMIR PATRIOT (Clayton Graham) who broke stretch and finish, #3 finished 5th and was placed 6th for failure to continuously lose ground while off stride (AGCO rule 22.27). Clear.
10. Driver of #6 ROAN BRUISER, Stephen Halkes, will attend the Judge’s office for a review of his urging in the stretch concerning AGCO rules 22.23.01 (b) (excessive) and 22.23.03 (a, b & c) (above head, beyond 90° relative to the track and outside the confines of the sulky). Clear.
