Race 5 - #6 "Downy Boy" ridden by Jesse Campbell was away slow. Spoke with Luis Contreras aboard #10 "Fahrenheit" following the race. He explained the horse was getting out with him down the backstretch and he was going to make his move going into the turn when the horse switched leads, felt really off in behind, like he was hopping. He didn't feel right to me so I eased him through the stretch. Spoke with the Official Vet who also spoke with Luis and received the same information, the Vet will attend the barn to have another look at the horse.

Race 6 – The Bull Page Stakes – Stewards Inquiry into the start regarding #1 "Sandretti" ridden by Kazushi Kimura, #2 "Blessed Two" ridden by Gary Boulanger and #3 "News Flash" ridden by Christopher Husbands. Kazushi said the outside two horse came over into me, lost my balance. Gary Boulanger said the #3 came in first couple jumps and forced me into the inside horse, nothing I could do to help him. Christopher said his horse broke hard to the inside, I did my best to straighten as quickly as I could. After review we disqualified #3 from fourth and placed him ninth behind #1.
