Backstretch

A call from race secretary Allen Hadley on Thursday, September 20/18, the horse JK Doc Carter was omitted on the overnight for the 3rd race Sunday September 24, 2018. The horse was entered into the race but was omitted and found after the draw of entries was completed and original overnight printed. As QH rule 6.39 provides, the horse was added to the outside of the field and a revised edition of the overnight was issued.

Owner/Trainer Richard Kennedy paid his monetary penalty as per QH Ruling #10950.

12:00 Upstairs, radio and timer checks ok

Race 1, #2 Barb's Winner reared in the gate and fell under, Veterinarian scratch and delay of 17 minutes as the horse was lodged under the gate. #4 Fire the Anchorman bore out and slow at start, #3 Miss Ought to go Now lugged in from the start to finish. Veterinarians reported Barb's Winner to be ok.

Race 3, #2 Zoooooooooooomin By, was unruly in the gate and advised by the veterinarian to be scratched. Stewards' Inquiry #4 Fly Me a Corona at the start, #4 appeared to refuse at the start but the handler hangs on to the horse and after speaking with the starter a total refund was ordered, rest good. Race 4, Stewards' Inquiry, #4 Fishin Feature, B. Bell, 1st and #3 Jess Tuff, C. Spataro, 7th at the start. Upon review of both camera angles, front tower and pan, #4 does bare down on #3 and #3 is forced on #2's heels. After speaking with the riders and review of the films, #4 was subsequently 1st placed 7th behind #3 for interference at the start.

Race 5, #5 Its Sweet Tobe First threw its head as starter dispatched the field and was off slow. #1 Slingin Pistol Annie lugged out throughout stretch, does go out to #3 Hanover Hill Sugar but is clear. Rest ok

Race 6, clear, was reported from the Official Veterinarian that #1 Tres Fortune had bled.

Race 7, #1, #2, #3 and #4 all made incidental contact from the break, no horse was hindered by the actions of the other, #6 Jess Rip slight stumble at start, rest good

Race 8, #7 Sweet Pagrana, unruly in the gate, on advisement of the Official Veterinarian, Sweet Pagrana is a veterinarian scratch. #4 Sw Hail to the King stumbled at the start, prevailed, rest good

Race 9, #2 Later Tater, 6th, bore out to #3 Night Fishin, 4th at the start, rest good
