Jockey Arienne Cox attended and licensed. Refreshed on our urging policy in Ontario.

Paddock Judge Harold Fortune attended, provided a detailed report of the issue regarding the Stewards scratch of Metadata in the fourth race yesterday after running off a mile. Jockey R. Hernandez called us after the race to explain that the horse still had full halter over the bridle and he had no control to pull the horse up. Horses are not to leave the paddock area with these halters in place without the cheek piece being removed. Unfortunately it was missed as the horse was saddled in the walking ring and joined post from there.

Trainer Josh Robillard contacted us and informed us that his horse, Pleasant Forest, 4th race today, was refused to load on the transfer van from Fort Erie. Has been a problem before, is a Stewards scratch and Mr. Robillard agreed to have the horse ship a day or two early next time entered at Woodbine.

Trainer Darren Glennon attended and signed the sub-trainer form for Scott Fairlie as Mr. Fairlie is away for a period of time.

Thomas Rohan attended to write the Agents' exam. Is to be representing Christopher Douglas.
