### Office:

Race 6, July 24, 2019, K. Kimura and E. Da Silva. L. Attard as rep. Kimura goes out to DaSilva approaching finish and they make contact. Dasilva beats Kimura. Educational review.

### Races:

Race 1, E. P. Taylor turf, #2 Chilling Secret bore out after start, rest ok

Race 2, reviewed run around far turn, back tower and apex camera angles, #4 Deputy of Egbert, K. Kimura, 7<sup>th</sup> and #9 Decisive Victory, D. Moran, 8<sup>th</sup>. Upon review #4 appears to lug out mid far turn over the heels of #9 as #9 goes by outside. Spoke with K. Kimura and he confirmed our take on the incident. No placings necessary. Reviewed stretch run, #7 Sure Would Forest, 3<sup>rd</sup>, S. Ryan and #2 G. Prince of Silver, 5<sup>th</sup> E. Da Silva, #7 bares in as they approach the finish to the #2 inside. Appeared to be right at the finish, no violations.

Race 3, Stewards' inquiry and Jockey claim of foul, #2 Derby Rebel 2<sup>nd</sup>, L. Salles, and #1 Moon

Magic, 3<sup>rd</sup>, E. Da Silva, approaching the finish, upon review of front tower and upper pan camera angles, #2 is moving laterally left under left handed urging forcing #1 to check as they make contact. #2 was 2<sup>nd</sup> placed 3<sup>rd</sup>. NOR for L. Salles.

#3 Toxicologist popped up at start, #2 Derby Rebel galloped out and was pulled up on the backstretch where L. Salles jumped off and horse was given transport to the backstretch by the horse ambulance.

Race 5, Inner turf, #6 North Battleford was squeezed at start, prevailed. #5 Clear Blue Sky was pulled up in the run down the backstretch, did not finish. rest ok

Race 6, E. P. Taylor turf, #4 Follow My Lead threw its head at start, #1, Viewfinder in tight looking for room at the top of stretch, reviewed stretch run with #6 Redoute's Light 1<sup>st</sup>, A. Garcia, and #3 Peace of Ekati, 2<sup>nd</sup> E. Wilson, they come together deep stretch, appears that #3 goes out to #6, no violations, rest ok

Race 7, #2 Thanks Again a late veterinarian scratch, #10 My Final Turn was eased through stretch, spoke with E. Da Silva, felt the horse was very green and not safe, rest ok
