Office:

09:15 - Groom Kathleen Lyons attended re: smoking in a no smoking area of barn one. Kathleen had no excuse. Monetary penalty of \$50.00

10:45 – Trainer Danny Vella attended to review yesterdays' fourth race in which his horse "Dance Ready" was disqualified. Mr. Vella seemed to be satisfied with the review of the head on video. Mr. Vella has requested a copy of the video.

11:00 - Race Secretary Scott Lane attended to discuss races on the inner turf where also eligibles are carded but due to the position of the fence the field is limited to 8 or 9 horses in the body. At issue is if the horses on the "Also" scratch, would those in the field be allowed to scratch out without being a Vet scratch. As fields are normally held to ten it is the position of the race office that scratches would not be allowed out of the body unless there is an "Also" that wishes to draw in. We advised Scott he needs to get the message to the horse people and relay to them the policy in these situations.

Film Reviews:

Review of yesterdays' fourth race involving Gary Boulanger, Justin Stein, Emma Wilson and David Moran. It was agreed Mr. Boulangers' mount does tip out at the top of the stretch and start a chain reaction. Gary said his horse was getting in with him off the turn but changed leads and drifted out with him just enough initiate the incident. Straightened as quick as he could but damage was done. We did not feel that Mr. Boulanger steered the horse out and did respond quickly to right the situation. No penalty issued.
