### Office:

- Review with Jacques Beaudoin concerning the seizure of unlabelled prescription medication from his stabling area on 29 August. Mr. Beaudoin admitted to possessing the medication seized and without a prescription. Decision reserved.
- Review with Jacques Beaudoin concerning his urging of DIAMOND CALL in the stretch at Rideau on 4 September. Mr. Beaudoin was informed as to what constitutes acceptable urging and the penalty structure for any violations; he has agreed to modify his driving technique in order to be compliant. No penalty.

### Races:

1. Inquiry on the performance of #4 ORLYS PRIDE (Richard Simard) who broke before and after the start and finished 4<sup>th</sup>, concerning possible broken equipment (driver reported both rear shoes were lost) before the start and the breaking rule; video review did not support one, or both, shoes being lost before the start (finished with broken equipment); no violation of the breaking rule.

Inquiry on #5 AIM HIGH HANOVER (Jacques Beaudoin) who broke before the start and had not reached the fair start pole when the starter released the field; refund: \$8377 (AGCO rule 22.03(l)). Clear.

2. LDL GEM #5 suffered broken equipment (Murphy blind) before the ¼ mile pole and finished first with broken equipment. Clear.
3. Inquiry on the performance of #4 PRECISION BLUE CHIP (Jonathan Lachance) who

broke after the start and finished 4<sup>th</sup> concerning the breaking rule; no violations. Clear.

4. Reviewed the break after the start by #3 STPADDYSDAY (Guy Gagnon), who finished 4<sup>th</sup>, concerning the breaking rule; no violations. Clear.

6. Discussed the race fractions (28<sup>1</sup> 59<sup>1</sup> 127<sup>2</sup> 156<sup>1</sup>) with the driver of #4 JANS LEGACY, Stephane Pouliot, who finished 6<sup>th</sup> and cut the mile until before the ¾ mile pole; the explanation of Mr. Pouliot concerning the second quarter was accepted and no penalty was assigned.

#5 SHADOW OF LINDY finished 9<sup>th</sup> (last) and was examined by the AGCO veterinarian after the race and placed on the veterinarians list (lame, short term); #5 qualifies for performance (trainer notified). Clear.

7. Reviewed racing in the last turn between #3 COURAGE (Simon Delisle) and #5 GLOBAL SUPREMACY (Pascal Berube); #3 did drift down forcing #5 into the pylons; #5 was charted with interference and Mr. Delisle was cautioned regarding keeping tighter control of his horse; no placing necessary as #5 finished ahead of #3.

Reviewed the break by #1 ZARCONIA SEELSTER (Robbie Robinson) before the ¼ mile pole; while off stride #1 did cause interference to #6 SUNSHINE CATCHER, #7 HONEYMOON DECHAFRA #8 ARTISTER J and #9 SHYTOWN SHADOW; #1 finished 8<sup>th</sup> and was placed 9<sup>th</sup> (last) for causing interference while off stride (AGCO rule 22.09). Clear.
