The rider of #1 Vanek said that the #6 came down on her in the turn causing her to clip heels, #2 Pinto called said she was directly behind and that the #6 came down. #6 Crawford said he heard yelling behind him but felt he had maintained his position on the outside. Film Review appears to show that the #6 comes in just enough to cause the #1 to clip a heel and stumble. #6 Alert Kitten finished 2<sup>nd</sup> and placed 4<sup>th</sup> for interference.
