Race 3 – The Overskate Stakes – Stewards Inquiry and Rider Claim of Foul by Daisuke Fukumoto aboard #5 “Silent Jimmie” against #4 “Speedy Connor” ridden by Kirk Johnson for interference during the stretch run. Daisuke said his horse was running good and had his space when the inside horse came out and took his path, had to check his horse. Kirk said his horse

was laying out with him and when he set him down for the run, his horse made a quick move out with him, tried his best to keep him straight. Spoke with Steven Bahen who was aboard #1 "Magical Man" and outside of Daisuke, Steven said he saw the inside horse come out and heard Daisuke yell, said he kept straight except when Daisuke was bothered he caught my horses hind end turning him in. After review, we disqualified #4 from third and placed it fourth behind #5.
