Report on day's Events: (Backstretch - accidents, fines, suspensions, objections, disqualifications, refunds, pertinent incidents, general details etc., Film Reviews, Races, Claims)

Backstretch:

Received a call from Trainer Michael De Paulo wishing to scratch two horses today. "Pressure Front" from the second and "Keen Artie" from the fourth. Said both horses are cribbers and both stalls have Chili Pepper on the walls and doors in an effort to prevent them from cribbing. Said he is worried that if tested, there would be the possibility of another positive. We allowed both horses to be excused.

We received notice that in todays first race, #5 "Divine Genesis" trained by Pat Parente, does not have the Foal Certificate on site. Papers were sent to Kentucky for correction and have not arrived back. Digital edition is also not available. Due to the horse being a two year old first time starter, it cannot be properly identified. Horse was scratched by the Stewards. AGCO rule 6.44.01 - No horse shall be permitted to enter unless it has been tattooed and fully identified.

Film Reviews:

Review of yesterdays' seventh race with Jerome Lermyte, Keveh Nicholls and Luis Contreras. Luis said it was getting tight and he kept hearing Keveh Nicholls yelling at Jerome, could see the outside horse coming over and realized I needed to get out of there, happened fast and couldn't get out quick enough. Keveh said he was yelling at Jerome and he just kept coming over, couldn't give Luis a chance because I was on Jerome's heels, had to check hard. Jerome said it was Keveh who interfered with Luis and that he was clear of Keveh, never bothered him. After

discussion it was decided the video did not support Jerome's case and that he was careless in his actions which warranted a three day suspension, days to be determined.

Races:

Race 1 – Stewards Inquiry into the stretch run involving #7 "Nero Davola" ridden by Sahin Civaci. As they approach the eighth pole, Sahin was going to the front when his horse started lugging in, brushed the inside rail then his mount tried to jump it, vaulting Sahin onto and over the fence. The horse does get up and continue down the track, shaken but seemingly unharmed. Sahin said he wasn't sure but when she brushed the fence it may have scared her and she attempted to go over it. Sahin was assessed by EMS and cleared to ride. Vet reported the horse was ok.
