Race 2, clear, call from #2 P. Mailhot, stated that #1 H. Vanek impeded his progress with her crop around the far turn, reviewed the back tower and apex camera angles, no evidence to support his querie.

Race 3, Turf, #7 Doctor Robert bore in slightly at start to #6 Baddest Blues, incidental contact, rest good

Race 4, clear

Race 5, Turf, #6 Savoia popped up at start, rest ok

Race 6, Stewards Inquiry, regarding #6 Shamruckus at the start, spoke with rider M. Buchanan, horse reared on his own, reviewed back tower and upper pan camera angles. #6 Shamruckus deemed to have received a fair start.

Race 7, Turf, Slight delay, #9 reared and unseated P. Mailhot, on advisement of the Official Veterinarian #9 Machisima was a Veterinarian scratch. Stewards inquiry, #6, Klassy Delight, 1st, D. Johnson and #5 Einsteins' Babe, 5th B. Wilson, run into the first turn. Review of front tower and upper pan camera angles, #6 angles over to the rail when not clear and #5 has to check hard. D. Johnson was not aware of the incident and B. Wilson on #5 felt it did cost him a position. #6 1st placed 5th. NOR for D. Johnson. And B.
