Report on day's events:

(Accidents, claims, fines and/or suspensions, objections and/or disqualifications, refunds and any other pertinent incidents)

Office:

- Racing Manager Peter Andrusek reported that the track was graded with the addition of material today.
- Disclosure pertaining to Certificate of Positive Analysis number 4524221003 was delivered to the trainer of PIZZAZZ HANOVER, Jeremy Marcotte, by email.
- Early Veterinary scratch (sick) of CENTURY JAZZ (Stephane Pouliot trainer) from the second race; this horse is entered on the short term (seven days) Veterinarians List.
- Early Judges scratch (injured) of HELLAS ROCKET (Sebastien Turenne trainer) from the second race on the advice of AGCO Veterinarian Dr. L. Berthiaume Atack.
- Early Judges scratch (transportation) of WELLWORTHTHEWAIT (Brian Scott trainer) from the fifth race.
- Early Judges scratch (other) of TRION DE VIE (Eric Lafleur trainer) from the sixth race.

Races:

- Melanie Plourde, William Roy and Robert Shepherd each excused from one drive, Stephane Brosseau and Pascale Berube each excused from two drives and Guy Gagnon excused from four drives.
1. Reviewed the performance of #4 WILD AND CRAZY (Ryan Guy) before the ½ mile pole and after the ¾ mile pole; at each position #4 was inside a single pylon; no violation of the inner rail rules and no placing. Clear.

2. The #7 HARDOO PARKING (Darcy Clancy) suffered broken equipment (bridle) after the start and finished with broken equipment. Clear.
3. Clear.
4. Discussed race pace with the driver of #6 CLEOMAX DUHARAS, Loic Gueriel, concerning the second quarter (28⁴ 100⁴ 130² 158⁴); considering the class of the race, how the race unfolded and that the trailing horses were not impeded, no penalty is assessed although Mr. Gueriel was cautioned regarding AGCO rule 22.05.01(k) (pace comparable to class). Clear.
5. Reviewed racing around the last turn regarding #6 DYLAN'S BANK (Ryan Guy), who contacted two pylons, and #4 HES GOT A VENDETTA (Kyle Forgie), who contacted one pylon; no violation of the inner rail rule in either case nor any placings. Clear.
6. Inquiry concerning possible interference to #9 CARSON'S STAR CHOICE (Guy Gagnon) by #1 HOWIE'S MAN (Joshua Miller) before the start; #1 broke before and after the start and while off stride before the start did cause interference to #9 who was a parimutuel refund of \$17,117; no placing necessary as #1 finished eighth (last).

Reviewed the break by #1 before the start concerning possible broken equipment, which was not evident in the video; #1 suffered broken equipment (head pole) after the start and finished with broken equipment. Clear.
7. The #7 GATOR HANOVER (Guy Gagnon) was examined by the AGCO Veterinarian post race with a determination of no abnormalities. Clear.
