

Backstretch:

- Association Veterinarians on duty at Woodbine today are Dr. Oscar Calvete & Dr. Brett Anderson.
- From race eight yesterday #1 Arashi (\$15,000) Owner: Bruno Schickedanz, Trainer: Kerron Palmer. Opted in for observation and was cleared by the Association Veterinarian.

Race 1:

- All clear.

Race 2:

#1 Break the Spell (Skye Chernetz), (finished first) was away slow but prevailed.

Race 3:

- The photo finish was not available due to an Operator error.
- Jockey and Trainer claim of foul #7 Spirit Bear (Keveh Nicholls), (finished third) on #4
 Mason's Music (Fraser Aebly), (finished first) at the top of the stretch. #4 moves outward
 towards the #7. The #7 does not lose momentum. Claim of foul was disallowed.

Race 4:

Reviewed racing midway through the stretch between #3 Nantuckets Day (Fraser Aebly), (finished sixth) and #6 Saccharine (Pietro Moran), (finished second). #3 is outside of #6 and takes a step inward towards the #6 causing the #6 to turn outward. No placings were required.

Race 5:

- #8 Periwinkle (Jose Campos), (finished second) popped up at the start.
- #5 Closing Appeal (Eswan Flores), (finished eighth) was in tight going into the turn.

Race 6:

- The starting gate stall did not have a #10 above the door, it had no effect on the running of the race.

Race 7:

- All clear.

Race 8:

Stewards' inquiry and Jockey claim of foul #9 Gastown Babe (Pietro Moran), (finished fourth) on #5 Loon Cry (Sahin Civaci), (finished first) in the stretch. #5 is on the outside as he is going by horses inside of him. #5 is clear when doing so as it tightens up for inside horses. The Jockey claim of foul was disallowed.

Race 9:

 The Stewards reviewed racing into the far turn. #2 Minedandrefined (Eswan Flores), (finished seventh) doesn't negotiate going into the turn very well. Jockey Flores stated that the filly wears a special bit and didn't get into the turn well.

Race 10:

- Jockey and Trainer claim of foul in the turn and in the stretch, #8 Peggy (Emma-Jayne Wilson), (finished third) on #1 Cozy Curlin Kitten (Sahin Civaci), (finished first). #1 and #8 bump in the turn and in the stretch, the #8 is never impeded. Jockey and Trainer claim of foul disallowed.
