Report on day's Events: (Backstretch - accidents, fines, suspensions, objections, disqualifications, refunds, pertinent incidents, general details etc., Film Reviews, Races, Claims)

Backstretch:

- Association Veterinarians on duty at Woodbine today are D.V.M. Oscar Calvete & D.V.M. Matt Nugent.

Race 1:

- #6 Ashbury (Pietro Moran), (finished first) stumbled on the break but prevailed.
- #7 Ravello Beauty (Ryan Munger), (finished sixth) was away slow.

Race 2:

- #2 Stayhonor Goodside (Sahin Civaci), (finished third) was squeezed between horses shortly after the break, no placings were required.

Race 3:

- Clear.

Race 4:

- Stewards' inquiry and Jockey claim of foul #5 Fanore (Fraser Aebly), (finished second) on #3 Lucky Romance (Ryan Munger), (finished first) in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole. #3 is outside of #5, takes a step inwards and bumps the #5. The #5 never loses momentum. Jockey claim of foul was disallowed.

- Maiden two-year-olds.
- Reviewed the break, #9 Notorious Gangster (Fraser Aebly), (finished third) breaks inward on the first few jumps into the rear of #8 Kokomo (Sofia Vives), (finished first) turning the #9 outward. The #9 prevails.
- Reviewed shortly after the start, it gets tight for several horses.
- Reviewed going into the first turn, it gets tight for several horses.

Race 7:

- #6 Taranto Titan (David Moran), (finished fifth) reared up on the break.
- Post race, the Stewards spoke to Jockey Sahin Civaci (#9 Onenightstandards), (finished third). Mr. Civaci stops riding momentarily in the stretch. Mr. Civaci stated that his cap brim was turned down, that he couldn't see, and it was for safety reasons. Mr. Civaci was cautioned about standing up before the wire. The Stewards will be holding a review with Mr. Civaci on Friday August 8, 2024.
