1. Inquiry on #1 DA CAPTAINOBVIOUS (Ryan Guy), who finished first, concerning possibly leaving the course before the ¼ mile pole; #1 did go inside two consecutive pylons and contact the subsequent pylon; after leaving the course #1 did break and while off stride did cause interference to #2 SUNDANCE LEYO (Guy Gagnon) and #5 HELLAS ROCKET (Sebastien Turenne); #1 finished first placed third (AGCO rule 22.09).
