- Paddock Judge Ernie O'Dwyer attended regarding paddock issues; participants are reminded that the Paddock and Paddock Judges Office are restricted areas.
- Racing Manager Peter Andrusek attended regarding an incident in the backstretch on 10 October; a report is to be provided regarding this incident.
- Driver Jimmy Gagnon has been advised that his outstanding monetary penalties are to be satisfied by 20 October.
