- Track Surfaces Manager Jeff Taylor, accompanied by Bob Eaton, attended to discuss track surface requirements and standards relative to Policy Directive No. 2-2010 and AGCO rule 18.08.02 (pylon standards).
- Early Veterinary scratch (sick) of SILVERADO (Wayne Laviolette trainer); this horse is entered on the short term (seven days) Veterinarians List.
- Virtual review with Dany Mainguy (translation provided by Paddock Judge O'Dwyer) regarding incidents in the test barn on 29 August and 12 September 2024 at Rideau Carleton; after discussing the findings of the investigation and relevant AGCO rules, specifically AGCO rules 6.17(c & d) (improper language and improper conduct) and 6.20(b) (misconduct), the panel reserved their decision.
