



Regulatory Fee for Cannabis Retail Store Authorization Transfers
Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (“AGCO”) Board Resolution

September 23, 2024

WHEREAS Regulation 468/18 made under the *Cannabis Licence Act, 2018* will be amended on January 1, 2025, by adding section 16.1 that will allow the Registrar of the AGCO to transfer a cannabis retail store authorization to a person who holds a cannabis retail operator licence as of January 1, 2025;

AND WHEREAS section 13 of the *Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario Act, 2019* (the “Act”) provides the Board of the AGCO with the power to establish fees or other charges, subject to the Approval of the Minister, for the administration of the Acts described in section 3 of the Act or the regulations made under them, including the *Cannabis Licence Act, 2018*.

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved That:

1. The Board of the AGCO establishes, subject to the approval of the Minister, a fee for the administration of the *Cannabis Licence Act, 2018* as set out in **Schedule 1** attached to this Board Resolution.
2. For greater clarity, the fee as set out in **Schedule 1** attached to this Board Resolution will begin to apply no earlier than January 1, 2025, when the amendment to section 16.1 of Regulation 468/18 comes into force.
