RACES

Race 3 – Reviewed pylons on #4 T Woodley (Colin Kelly) around the final turn, finished 4th – races inside one pylon, no violations of the AGCO pylon rule.

Race 4 – Reviewed the break by #5 My Time Your Money (Robert Jenkins Jr) before the half and in the stretch, finished 5th – no violations of the AGCO breaking rule.

- #1 My Sweet MVP (J Bradley Harris) finished distanced and must qualify for Performance.

Race 5 – Reviewed pylons on #2 Saulsbrook Cami (Austin Sorrie) in the first turn, finished 3rd – races inside one pylon, no violations of the AGCO pylon rule.

- #6 Kadabrakaboom (Mark Macdonell) was charted with interference due to the break by #7 Archangels Gliding (Samuel Fillion) in the stretch, no placings needed.

Race 6 – #1 Macho Polo (Damien Maclellan) finished 6th placed 7th for racing inside two consecutive pylons around the final turn and being lapped on at the finish.
