Races:

Race 1: #1 Derf Hanover was scratched after warming up and put on the Short-Term Vet's List (lame) by the Official Veterinarian.

Reviewed the break of #6 Off Road Hanover before and after the start.

Race 2: Race winner #6 House Edge Hanover had sufficient room to move into the flow before the half mile mark.

Reviewed the breaks of #4 Keepamericagreat after the quarter and before the half mile mark.

Race 3: Slight delay due to a pair of mated geese on the track at the start/finish line.

Reviewed the breaks #6 All Out Marilyn after the half and three-quarter mile mark.

#6 All Out Marilyn was placed on the Long-Term Vet's List (lame) post race by the Official Veterinarian.

Race 4: #5 Belvedere Kathy must qualify for breaks.

Race 5: Inquiry: Reviewed racing going into the last turn, #5 Cellular (D.Thiessen), finished 3rd, and #4 Thirddimesthedream (J.Ryan), finished 6th. Both drivers were going into the same spot, no violations or interference confirmed by driver J.Ryan.

Race 9: Inquiry: As the horses headed into the stretch behind the gate, the two geese were on the track. The starter blew the horn to try to scare but did not flash the recall lights. As a result, the entire race was refunded, and all horses were charted with interference before and after the start. Refund: \$35988. No one pulled up, raced, and the was able to be adjudicated, and purse money was paid out accordingly.
