Jockey Jason Hoyte excused from his mounts today

Trainer Steve Flint attended and provided us with the piece of equipment that he initially wished to use on his horse Social Code in the 8th race yesterday. He explained that this horse is large in size and that she has very high withers, the piece of equipment is not advantageous or a hinderance to the horse in racing and is used in the best interests of welfare to the horse. It was not used yesterday as Jockey Ryan Munger's saddle did not sit correctly on the horse. It was determined the equipment is permitted for use in racing.

Jockey Walter Rodriquez tutored on the urging rules here in Ontario.

Official Veterinarians Dr. Oscar Calvete and Dr. Matt Nugent on duty today.

Race 1, No Show Wagering, #1 Souper Success, Sahin Civaci, 1st, steadied inside the 5/8 mile as the room slightly diminished towards the inside, prevailed. Rest ok

Race 2, #4 Its Just Money off a step slow and a little erratic, reviewed run at the ¼ and through stretch regarding #3 Back River, Juan Crawford, 6th, was trying to avoid heels as #2 was moving out slightly at the ¼ and #7 to his outside, had to steady, appeared to be tiring and wavering in the stretch run. Rest good.

Race 3, All clear

Race 4, #3 Just Pray, unseated Raphael Hernandez on the way out to the track, ran off and was subsequently a Steward scratch, refund of \$9,713. #4 Misty Eyed, S. Chernetz, 6th, broke awkwardly and was eased throughout. Spoke with Skye Chernetz who stated her saddle had slipped up the horses' neck and was unable to continue safely. This was confirmed on video replay. Rest ok.

Race 7, Woodstock Stakes, Stewards' Inquiry and Jockey claim of foul, #5, Incoming, Ryan Munger, 4th, on #4 Big Vince, W. Rodriguez, 2nd, after the start, upon review of back tower and upper pan camera angles, #4 does move outwardly across 3 paths forcing #5 to check hard, after speaking with the jockeys involved and review it was determined that the #4 did interfere with #5 and was subsequently disqualified from 2nd and placed 4th. Jockey Walter Rodriguez was not given any penalty.
