## Report on day's events:

## Office:

- The emergency lights and siren were tested prior to the qualifying races this afternoon and both are fully functional.
- Early Judges scratches (transportation) of BLUEMEA KISS (Nicholas Boyd trainer) from the third race and BLAKESAGENT (Randy Ertel trainer) from the tenth race.
- Early Veterinary scratches (sick) of MY ONLY SUNSHINE (Mark Winacott trainer) from the seventh race and T WOODLEY (Amanda Riley trainer) from the ninth race; these horses are entered on the short term (seven days) Veterinarians List.
- Discussed MENDIETA in the eighth race on 17 May not showing the horse would race with trotting hopples with trainer Jason Ryan; the explanation of Mr. Ryan was accepted and no penalty is assigned relative to AGCO rule 22.25 (reporting equipment changes).

## Races:

- Discussed race pace with the driver of the race winner #5 BELLA, Isaac Waxman regarding the second quarter (28<sup>4</sup> 1002 130 159<sup>3</sup>); considering the track condition Mr. Waxman was cautioned and reminded of driver's obligation when cutting the mile relative to AGCO rule 22.05.01(k). Clear.
- 2. Inquiry concerning breaking horses before and after the start.

The #3 CASH OUT HALL (Damian Maclellan) and #7 BARNYARD BRENDA (Nicholas Boyd) broke before the start and had passed the fair start pole when the starter released the field; both horses did receive a fair start.

The #3 broke after the start and finished fourth; no violation of any of the breaking rules by #3 and no change to the order of finish. Clear.

- 3. Inquiry on #6 HAPUNA BEACH (Samuel Filion) concerning possible broken equipment before the start; the #6 suffered broken equipment (head pole) after the start, did receive a fair start and finished second with broken equipment. Clear.
- 4. Inquiry and driver's objection concerning possible interference to #4 ALL ABOUT ART (Terry Hefferman), who finished ninth, by #8 FEARGIVER (John Thomson), who finished eighth, after the start; after reviewing the race video and speaking with both drivers it was determined that #8 had beared in and caused interference to #4; #8 finished eighth placed ninth (AGCO rule 22.09). Mr. Thomson will attend a review regarding AGCO rule 22.05.01(a) (bear in causing interference). Clear.
- 5. The #6 GAMBLER GASS (Reg Gassien) broke before the ¾ mile pole, pulled up and did not finish; #6 qualifies for performance (trainer notified); the #6 was examined by the AGCO Veterinarian post race and entered on the short term (seven days) Veterinarians list for sickness. Clear.
- 6. Reviewed racing before the ½ mile pole between the race winner #4 BIG BULLY (Darcy Clancy) and #6 JOHNSTOWN JET (Isaac Waxman), who finished sixth; after reviewing the race video and speaking with both drivers (Mr. Clancy stated #6 had beared in on him; Mr. Waxman stated his horse was tiring after being parked out from the start, was backing through the field and he was trying to put him on the rail) the #4 was charted with interference; no placing necessary as #6 finished sixth (last). Clear.
- 7. The #7 ALLBOUTTHEMATERIAL (Jason Woodward) suffered broken equipment (shoe) after the start and finished with broken equipment. Clear.
- 8. Clear.
- 9. Inquiry on #1 HENDERSON SEELSTER (Keith Jones, who finished third, at the start; #1 broke before the start but was on stride when the starter released the field; no violation of the breaking rules by #1 and no change to the order of finish. Clear.
