Race 1:

- Slight delay to the start of this race due to a problem with the starting gate.
- #4 Halcon Negro was fractious, got loose, and was subsequently scratched by the Stewards.
- #2 Friendly (Jeffery Alderson), (finished second) was away slow.
- #5 Hard Reload (Brooke Bays), (finished fifth) the rider lost a stirrup shortly after the break.

Race 2:

- #3 Its Just Money (Xarel Forde), (finished first) was away slow but prevailed.

Race 3:

- The Stewards spoke to Jockey Skye Chernetz (#1 Her Obsession), (finished sixth). Ms. Chernetz stated that she had trouble maintaining her position.

Race 4:

- Clear.

Race 5:

- #2 I'm Tenacious (Austin Adams), (finished third) broke inward as the #1 Looks Lucky to Me (Daisuke Fukumoto), (finished fifth) breaks outward on the second jump. There were no violations.

Race 6:

- #4 Chancel (Juan Crawford), (finished sixth) was away slow.

Race 7:

- Stewards' inquiry and Jockeys claim of foul #6 Adelaide Court (Da-Sean Gaskin), (DNF) on #7 Royal Hudson (Keveh Nicholls), (finished first) and #8 Ry Pie (Juan Crawford), (finished fourth and was disqualified).
- in the vicinity of the five-eighths pole. #8 comes across the path of the #6 in the vicinity of the five-eighths and causes the #6 to catch heels and unseats the rider of #6. #8 finished fourth and was disqualified for causing interference to #6. The number #7 was not involved in the incident.
