Office:

 Discussed the recurring teletimer problems since the wireless system was installed with Racing Manager Peter Andrusek and Randy Miller and Gerald Hill of ONTrack. All are now informed of the importance of correct times being displayed and ONTrack and Rideau Carleton will prioritize ensuring proper functionality of the system.

Races:

- Jacques Beaudoin and Pascal Berube each excused from one drive.
- Inquiry on the performance of the race winner #5 FARMERDONTDILYDALI (Guy Gagnon) after the ³/₄ mile pole; #5 did bear out from the rail to three wide allowing the #7 TWICE THE DELIGHT (Ryan Guy) inside; after speaking with Mr. Gagnon (stated the horse is green and was trying to pull up) and the trailing horse #3 WHISKEY FRIDAY driver Robert Shepherd (stated he was not bothered by #5) and reviewing the race video it was determined there were no violations and no placings necessary. Clear.

2. Inquiry and driver's objection concerning possible interference by #5 HANDSOFFNOSEIN (William Roy), who finished second, on #2 DJ COWBOY (Ryan Guy), who finished third, after the ³/₄ mile pole; after speaking with both drivers (Mr. Guy stated #5 had beared in and hooked his wheel; Mr. Roy stated his horse had beared in) and reviewing the race video it was determined that #5 had hooked the outside wheel Page 2 of #3 causing this horse to break (charted with an interference break); all trailing horses were charted with interference: #1 ALLSTAR BALLERINA (Stephane Pouliot); #3 DA PLAYERSDELIGHT (Mike Healey); #4 LITTLE KASSARA (Clarke Steacy); #6 CB CAPER (Robert Shepherd); #7 WICKED MOVE (Guy Gagnon); objection upheld; #5 finished second placed seventh for causing interference (AGCO rule 22.09).

Following the placing the incorrect numbers (leaving #5 second) were made official, which were immediately corrected demoting the #5 to seventh with correct order of finish 7-2-4-6. Clear.

Inquiry on the race winner #1 CAPTAINOFROCKNROLL (Guy Gagnon) concerning possible interference to #9 DUCK DYNASTY (Stephane Pouliot) before the start; #1 broke before the start but was back in position behind the gate when the starter released the field and was not charted with a break; Mr. Pouliot stated he was not interfered with as he had moved behind the #2; no violations and no change to the order of finish.
