Office: Ryan Guy requested to walk his horse on the grass inside the safety lane after the post parade. Permission was granted if he stays on the edge of the infield, does not venture into the middle of the infield or delay the start of the race.

Racing manager Peter Andrusek confirmed that the safety lane will be free of grass by the weekend.
