### Report on day's events:

**Office:** Ryan Guy requested to walk his horse on the grass inside the safety lane after the post parade. Permission was granted if he stays on the edge of the infield, does not venture into the middle of the infield or delay the start of the race.

Racing manager Peter Andrusek confirmed that the safety lane will be free of grass by the weekend.

**Race 1:** #1 Friar Voltaire finished with broken equipment. (shoe)

**Race 2:** Clear.

**Race 3:** Clear.

**Race 4:** Reviewed the break of #7 Napoleon Hill before the half mile mark. #7 Napoleon Hill must qualify for breaks.

**Race 5:** Clear.

**Race 6: Inquiry #1:** #8 Southwind Mac (G.Gagnon), on the lead heading into the last turn bore out and caused interference to #3 Diara (R.Shepherd). As a result, #8 Southwind Mac finished 2<sup>nd</sup> and was placed 7<sup>th</sup>. #3 Diara was charted with interference. No penalty to driver Gagnon as the horse was racing "green" on the lead.

**Inquiry #2:** #1 Candyspot made a break before the start and was outside the fair start pole. Refund: \$998.00.

Reviewed the break before and after the start of #6 Orlys Angel, finished 6<sup>th</sup> placed 5<sup>th</sup>, did not violate any of the AGCO breaking rules.

**Race 7:** Slight delay of post time as live video feed was compromised.

Reminded driver David Pilon that his feet are to always remain in the stirrups during the race. Official warning placed on his driver license.

**Race 8:** Reviewed after the start, #4 Ima Dude, finished 5<sup>th</sup>, appeared to jump something on the track but did not make a break.

**Race 9:** Delay of the start of the race as #5 J M Stella and #6 Synergy S had their saddle cloths reversed. Both horses were trained by Kelly Duval Lacaille and returned to the paddock. It was announced that #5 J M Stella would be driven by R. Shepherd and #6 Synergy S by S. Lacaille as he must drive the horse he owns. Upon further review S. Lacaille is the bona fide owner of Ferme Canaco Farm Inc. and therefore both horses were driven as programmed.

Recall charged to #6 Synergy S due to broken equipment. (shoe)
