RACES

Race 1 – Reviewed racing in the first turn – no violations.

- #1 Vino Louie (J Bradley Harris) finished distanced and must qualify for Performance, Tr. Clare Bradshaw notified. Dr. Meyers checked the horse following the race and reported OK.

Race 2 – Inquiry X 2 at the top of the stretch.

- Inquiry #1 – Reviewed possible pylon violation by #2 Flash Cube (Guy Gagnon), finished 2nd. The front tower video shows #2 races inside the yellow pylon that leads into the open stretch passing lane. AGCO Rule 22.05.02.2(iii) reads, 'horses using the open stretch must first have complete clearance of the pylons.' The Panel ruled

#2 gained an unfair advantage on #6 Socrates Blue Chip (Bob McClure) by entering the open stretch passing lane without complete clearance. As a result, #2 finished 2nd and was placed 4th for a pylon violation.

- Inquiry #2 – Reviewed the break by #5 Candy Trader (Sylvain Filion), finished 3rd PL 2nd – no violations of the AGCO breaking rule.

Race 3 – All Clear

Race 4 – Inquiry at the start – Reviewed the breaks by #2 Bad Eye Bill (Brett MacDonald) and #9 Moonshine Willy (Lorne House) – both horses ruled to have broke on their own and received a fair start.

- Break by #5 Twin B Powerball (Travis Cullen) – horse suffered an equipment break (hobble) after the start; received a fair start.

- #8 Country Boy Tough (Phil Hudon) was charted with interference due to the break by #5.
