Five Grassroots Divisions (2yo Pace Fillies) - Races 1, 2, 3, 4 & 6

**Races:**

**Race1:** Grassroots Division 1 - Clear

**Race2:** Grassroots Division 2 - INQUIRY – Reviewed first turn. #2 “Favourite Beach” (finished 2<sup>nd</sup>) was inside only 1 pylon, no violation.

**Race3:** Grassroots Division 3 - Clear - #3 “Prove Em Wrong” distanced, must qualify

**Race4:** Grassroots Division 4 - Clear

**Race5:** Clear

**Race6:** Grassroots Division 5 - Clear

**Race7:** “Walker Trot”-- Prior to race, Late Scratch of #8 “Sizzlen Hot Herbie” – lost a glue-on shoe, farrier unable to replace shoe in paddock.

INQUIRY – Reviewed 1<sup>st</sup> turn. #4 “Charmbro Prince” (1<sup>st</sup>) inside 1 pylon twice but not in succession. No Violation. Rest clear

**Race8:** INQUIRY: Reviewed Break before the ¼ by #3 “Derby Dylan” (3<sup>rd</sup>) – did obey breaking rules, did not interfere with any other horse, no change. Rest Clear

**Race9:** Balanced Image Final – Numerous breaks, none of which affect the Top 4 finishers

\*\* At 3/4 , #1 breaks, causes an interference break to #5. Thus, the # 1 is placed behind the # 5

\*\* At the start, both #4 and #6 make extended breaks (>25 strides) Thus # 4 is placed last (8<sup>th</sup>) while the # 6 is placed second last (7<sup>th</sup>)

The only change to the Top 5 positions is that #5 is 7<sup>th</sup> placed 6<sup>th</sup>, placed 5<sup>th</sup>, due to the above noted incidents

**Race10:** INQUIRY: Reviewed break of # 8 “Carson Star Choice”(4<sup>th</sup>) before the ¼ - It is determined that he caused interference to #5 “Barstow Belle” (5<sup>th</sup>) – Thus #8 is DQ’d from 4<sup>th</sup> and placed 5<sup>th</sup>, and #5 is 5<sup>th</sup> placed 4<sup>th</sup> – and #5 is charted with interference.
