Office: Chad Rozema was training to be a Race Official this evening.

One division of 3yo Trotting Fillies – Ontario Sires Stakes – Gold Series - 1<sup>st</sup> leg (Race 4)

From Race 5 on May 18<sup>th</sup>, Jonathan Drury was found in violation of AGCO rule 22.23.03 (b), did use more than wrist action while urging Momas Son Byrne, monetary penalty of \$300 and a five day driving suspension from June 2<sup>nd</sup> to June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024 inclusive. Ruling #2670121.

Races:

Race 1: Clear.

Race 2: #2 Southwind Domino was programmed in error without trotting hobbles. The horse raced with hobbles and it was announced to the public before the race.

Race 3: Clear.

Race 4: Clear.

Race 5: #8 Reactor Now A (D.McNair) drifted off the rail mid way through the stretch, allowing #5 The Greek Freak, finished 2<sup>nd</sup> to pass along the rail. No penalty to McNair as his horse was running out and attempt was made to keep the horse tight to the rail.

#8 Reactor Now A finished with broken equipment. (shoe)

Race 6: #1 Lexus Angel made a break after the three-quarter pole, unofficially finished 7<sup>th</sup>, had an extended break. #5 Kinnder Hotblood made a break before the quarter mile pole, unofficially finished 5<sup>th</sup>, had an extended break. #8 No One made a break before the three-

quarter pole, unofficially finished 8<sup>th</sup>, had an extended break.

Working from the finish line to the start, the placings were #1 Lexus Angel finished 7<sup>th</sup>, placed 8<sup>th</sup>, placed 7<sup>th</sup>, placed 6<sup>th</sup>.

#5 Kinnder Hotblood finished 5<sup>th</sup> placed 8<sup>th</sup>.

#7 Valuable Miss 6<sup>th</sup> placed 5<sup>th</sup>.

#8 No One finished 8<sup>th</sup>, placed 7<sup>th</sup>, placed 8<sup>th</sup>, placed 7<sup>th</sup>.

#1 Lexus Angel must qualify for breaks.

Race 7: **Inquiry:** Race winner #3 Rock And Twist (L.P.Roy) had already moved to the outside off the rail as #6 Wry (T.Borth) was advancing in the flow. No violations.

Race 8: #8 All Wrapped Up (L.P.Roy), finished 5<sup>th</sup>, was inside 2 pylons around the last turn but was not lapped on at the finish.

Race 9: Clear.

Race 10: #1 Captain Fireball, #2 Maintenance Man and #3 Treacherous Tom were charted with interference from the break of #7 Lets Tie One On after the three quarter pole.

#7 Lets Tie One On pulled up and did not finish and placed on the Judges' list for performance. Also, the horse was placed on the Long-Term Vet's List (lame) by the Commission Veterinarian.

Race 11: #10 Capt Jack Hanover was placed on the Judges' List for performance and must qualify. Also, the horse was placed on the Short Term Vet's List (sick).
