Office:

- Virtual review held with driver Tyler Jones from the fifth race on 5 November while driving PANTHEON SEELSTER regarding AGCO rule 22.05.01(h) (contact another sulky). Mr. Jones was adjudged guilty of violating this rule and assessed a three day driving suspension (28-30 November, inclusive) (Number1106315).

Races:

1. Start delayed as #1 ASA IM READY (Stephane Brosseau) would not turn. Reviewed the performance of #5 ORLYS PRIDE (Richard Simard), who finished third, in the last turn concerning possibly leaving the course; #5 did contact one pylon and go inside one pylon; no violations.

Inquiry concerning possible interference by the race winner #1 on #4 MONTANABLACK ANGEL (Tyler Jones), who finished second, before the ¼ mile pole; after speaking with the drivers and reviewing the race video it was determined that #4 was wide on the turn allowing sufficient clearance for #1 to move two wide; no violations. 2. Reviewed the performance of #3 JOURNALISTIC (Philip Reid) who broke before the start and finished second; #3 did not have any broken equipment at the start, was well inside the fair start pole when the starter released the field and did receive a fair start. Clear.
