Report on day's events:

(Accidents, claims, fines and/or suspensions, objections and/or disqualifications, refunds and any other pertinent incidents)

Office:

- Early Veterinary scratches (sick) of LADY TO WATCH from the second race and SNAKKE SNAKKE from the fifth race; these horses are entered on the short term (seven days) veterinarians list.
- Program correction for WHATS IN THE ESKY in the seventh race as the driver was incorrect (entered with Melanie Plourde as the driver).
- Ruling (No. 1633385) generated awarding cancellation fees of \$300 to all eligible horses entered for Rideau Carleton on 6 March per AGCO rule 7.16.05(c) and Policy Directive No. 1-2009.

Races:

- Jacques Beaudoin excused from one drive.
1. Recall as #5 ON THE SLY (Samuel Fillion) had broken equipment (trotting hopple).

Inquiry regarding breaking horses:

- #4 FIX A DRINK (Jacques Beaudoin) broke after the start and was off stride for more than 25 consecutive strides; #4 finished 4th placed 6th (last) placed 5th per extended break rule (AGCO rule 22.27.02).
- #5 ON THE SLY (Samuel Fillion) broke before and after the ½ mile pole and was off stride for more than 25 consecutive strides; #5 finished 5th placed 4th placed

6th (last) per extended break rule (AGCO rule 22.27.02). This horse suffered broken equipment (trotting hopple) after breaking at the ½ mile pole and finished with broken equipment.

- #6 SOMETIMES WHEN (Stephane Brosseau) broke before and after the start, did not violate the extended break rule after the start, did not have broken equipment, had passed the fair start pole when the starter released the field and did receive a fair start.

4. Driver of #4 SHADOW MOON, Jimmy Gagnon, was cautioned regarding his urging in the stretch. Clear.
5. The #6 SWING DALI SWING (Marie-Claude Auger) was rough at the finish, but did not break; this horse was examined by the AGCO Veterinarian and was reported to be asymptomatic. Clear.

7. Driver of #1 PRINT MEDIA, Jimmy Gagnon, will attend a review regarding his urging after the start. Clear.

Discussed race pace with the driver of #3 LOVEMYROCKINBIRD, Marie-Claude Auger, concerning the second quarter (27¹ 57⁴ 125³); considering the track condition and wind the explanation of Ms. Auger was accepted and no regulatory action is required although she was reminded of a driver's obligation to set a pace befitting the class. Clear.
11. The #8 SEEYOU MEN (Guy Gagnon) suffered broken equipment (martingale) after the start and finished with broken equipment. Clear.
12. Reminded the driver of #4 TWOMACHSONEMACH to maintain a safe distance between his horse and the preceding horse. Clear.

14. Reviewed racing going to the ¼ mile pole; while off stride #6 PEY BUG (Steeven Genois) did cause interference to #4 WISH KEY K (Guy Gagnon), #5 DE CHAIRMAN (Jimmy Gagnon) and an interference break to #8 MAJOR MOTION (Pascal Berube); no placing necessary as #6 finished behind the horses with whom it interfered.
