### Report on day's events:

### Office:

- Surface material (40 tonnes) applied to the track.
- Early Judges scratch (injured) of RAISING RUSTY from the third race by the trainer.
- Early Judges scratch (other) of MCJAGERSONTHEMOVE from the tenth race.
- Early vet scratch (lame) of BADSTORMANYPORT from the tenth race by the owner; this horse is entered on the short term (7 days) veterinarians list.
- Discussed the claim of THUNDERING JIM on 18 October from the eighth race with the primary claimant Gary McDonald.

### Races:

1. Recall as #1 ITS ALL WORTH IT (Jonathan Lachance) did score ahead of the starting gate. Clear.
2. Reviewed the performance of #6 BETTER THAN MEN (Mike Healey) who broke before the start; #6 did not have any broken equipment, was well inside the fair start pole when the starter released the field and did receive a fair start. STAGE TERROR (Darcy Clancy) #5 suffered broken equipment (flat tire) after the start and finished with broken equipment. Clear.
3. Clear.
4. Driver of #2 CASSIUS, Stephane Pouliot, was cautioned regarding his urging in the stretch. Clear.
5. Reviewed the break by #6 LUNAR LAUNCH (Rodney Laframboise) after the ¾ mile pole; while off stride #6 did cause interference to #1 DOC DARRYL (Clarke Steacy), #2

TJ THUNDER (Stephane Brosseau) and #8 COOL HAND LUCAN (Richard Simard); no placing necessary as #6 finished eighth (last). Clear.

6. Inquiry and driver's objections on #2 DUTCH SEELSTER (Guy Gagnon) before the ¼ mile pole; #2 appears to shy and break stride causing interference to the trailing horses, #1 SOPHIES CAM (Stephane Pouliot), who finished ninth, and #9 JANS LEGACY (Darcy Clancy), who finished third; objections upheld; #2 finished second placed ninth for causing interference while off stride (AGCO rule 22.09). Clear.
