Report on day's events:

(Accidents, claims, fines and/or suspensions, objections and/or disqualifications, refunds and any other pertinent incidents)

Office:

- Early Veterinary scratch (sick) of YOU GOT THIS from the seventh race; this horse is entered on the short term (seven days) veterinarians list.
- Early Judges scratches (transportation) of LAA DEE GAA from the fourth race and CAMLACHIE CHROME from the seventh race.
- Early Judges scratch (injured) of AMIGO MIO from the third race.

Races:

- Back tower video unavailable for the first race due to technical difficulties.
- 1. Late Veterinary scratch (lame) of KINDER PEACEOFMIND by the AGCO veterinarian; this horse is entered on the short term (seven days) veterinarians list; refund \$94. As there were only four horses remaining, fifth place money was retained by the Association (AGCO rule 18.02).

Inquiry concerning possible interference between #1 AMANDUS (Samuel Fillion) and #2 BOOMANDBUST (Jimmy Gagnon) around the last turn; these horses briefly hooked wheels due to tight racing, which did not impede the progress of either horse; no violations and no placing. Clear.

2. Late Judges scratch (other) of STRAIT TO THE POINT; refund: \$3. Clear.

- 3. Complaint from the driver of #6 DUKE LAVICTOIRE, Stephane Brosseau, that dust from the starting gate had caused his horse to break after the start; after reviewing the video of the start there was negligible dust visible.
 - Driver of #1 OVERSERVED, Guy Gagnon, was adjudged guilty of violating AGCO rule 22.05.01(k) (failure to set or maintain a pace comparable to class) regarding the second quarter (27⁴ 59³) and assessed a monetary penalty of \$100 (Number 1849072). Clear.
- 4. Clear.
- 5. Driver of #5 ROCKNROLL NATION, Pascal Berube, was cautioned regarding his urging in the stretch. Clear.
- 6. Reviewed racing before the ½ mile pole concerning #9 PRETTYDIVA (Jacques Beaudoin) leaving the course; #9 did go inside two consecutive pylons but was not lapped on; no violation and no placing. Clear.
- 7. Clear.
- 8. Discussed race pace with the driver of #5 CHARLIE BAR, Pierre Bovay, concerning the second quarter (28⁴ 100); the explanation of Mr. Bovay was partially accepted and no regulatory action is required, although he was reminded of a driver's obligation when cutting the mile. Clear.
- 9. Recall as #1 CROSSFIT (Jimmy Gagnon) did score ahead of the starting gate; the Starter, Jamie Fiolek, will hold a review with Mr. Gagnon regarding scoring ahead of the starting gate.

Inquiry on #6 BLACK TIE BASH (Robert Shepherd), who broke before the start and had not reached the fair start pole when the starter released the field; full parimutuel refund of #6 of \$7,282 (AGCO rule 22.03(I)). Clear.
