Report on day's events:

Office:

- MYBROTHERGEORGE was erroneously removed from the draw for the tenth race; this horse was properly declared and was subsequently added to the race and assigned post position seven (AGCO rule 17.15).
- Virtual meeting with driver Guy Gagnon concerning the fractions of the fifth race at Rideau Carleton on 4 July while driving THE LIGHT SPEED. The panel did review the race after the ¼ mile pole on 4 July concerning possible confusion and determined that #4 VANILLA MALTED (Stephane Brosseau) had driven up on #2 BS TYRRIFIC (Pascal Berube), and further that there were no violations, and no further action was required. Mr. Gagnon was reminded of a drivers' obligation when cutting the mile.
- Early Judges scratch (injured) of KATIE NANA from the second race and DELLAS BOY from the eighth race by the AGCO veterinarian Dr. Berthiaume-Atack.

Races:

1. Reviewed the performance of #1 OFFICIALLY RUSTY (Jacques Beaudoin) after the ½ mile pole; #1 did contact four consecutive pylons but did not leave the course. Clear.

4. Inquiry on the performance of #5 ARRHYTMOGENIC (Daniel St. Pierre) who broke before the start, was inside the fair start pole when the starter released the field, and

did receive a fair start; #5 suffered broken equipment (knee boot) after the start and finished with broke equipment.

Cautioned the driver of #6 VILLAGE JAMIE, Emil Toth, regarding keeping both feet in the stirrups for the entire mile. Clear.

5. Reviewed the performance of #1 BONITAS SUNSHINE (Donald Jobin), who broke before the ¼ mile pole; while off stride #1 did cause interference to #2 DEAN STREET (Stephane Brosseau); no placing necessary as #1 finished ninth (last); while off stride #1 suffered broken equipment (knee boot) and finished with broken equipment. The driver of #7 ST LADS SKIP, Ryan Guy, was cautioned regarding urging when not in contention. Clear.
6. Reviewed the performance of #3 SKY SPIRIT (Pierre Bovay) who broke before and after the start and finished fifth; no violation of the breaking rules by #3. Clear.

8. Reviewed the break by #1 THE BIG CHEESE (Emil Toth) before the ¼ mile pole; while off stride #1 did cause interference to #6 PAM AND LAURA (Ryan Guy); no placing necessary as #1 finished seventh (last).

Reviewed the break by #6 PAM AND LAURA (Ryan Guy) after the ¾ mile pole; while off stride #6 did cause interference to #2 STONEBRIDGE HERMES (Jacques Beaudoin); no placing necessary as #6 finished posterior to #2. The #6 was examined by the AGCO veterinarian Dr. Melissa Rocheleau post race and placed on the short term (seven day) veterinarians list due to lameness (trainer notified). Clear.
9. After the start #6 TASK BAR HANOVER (Jacques Beaudoin) suffered broken equipment (shoe) and finished with broken equipment. The driver of #5 PRINT MEDIA, Ryan Guy, will attend a review regarding his urging in the stretch. Clear.
10. Driver of #3 OUTLAWFRYREYESONLY, Normand Beaudoin, will attend a review regarding his urging in the stretch. Clear.
11. Driver of #6 STORMONT MUFFIN, Ryan Guy, will attend a review concerning his urging in the stretch. Clear.
