Upon review of the upper pan and front tower camera angles, #7 is moving out to the hind end of the #6. Claim of foul is disallowed. Following the 3rd race Jockey Justin Stein was excused from the remainder of his mounts.

Race 4, on the advisement of the Official Veterinarian, #4 Cotton was scratched at the gate after being fractious, refund \$147,246. Race all clear

Race 5, #4 Bayou Belle stumbled start, rest ok.
