Race 9, Princess Elizabeth Stakes, Jockey claim of foul, #7, J. Stein, 7th on #1, S. Civaci, 4<sup>th</sup> at the top of the stretch, upon review of the front tower and upper pan camera angles, #1 does go out to #7 as #7 has to check. J. Stein felt that it did cost him a position. S. Civaci felt he stayed straight. After due consideration #1 Hurricane Clair was disqualified from 4<sup>th</sup> position and placed 7<sup>th</sup> for interference with #7.
