Backstretch:

Jockey Patrick Husbands excused from his mount today.

Spoke with Starter Ian Ross, he advised us that the 2 year old filly Alberta Be Mine, trained by Sid Attard be excused from the 2nd race today due to an issue with the horse being gate schooled the past two days.

Discussion with Woodbine Race Officials regarding the horse Mylady, entered into the EP Taylor Stakes tomorrow, race 9. The horse has been unruly during training and a request was made to have the horse excused from post parade for the race. A decision based upon the best interests of racing and horse welfare was to allow the request to be granted.

Film Reviews:

Race 9, October 2, 2022. Rafael Hernandez and Justin Stein, Larry Attard as rep. Breeders' Stakes, Hernandez aboard #7 Dancin in Danile, ducks in at the top of the stretch down to #8 Duke of Love, Stein and forces that one to check hard. It was determined that the horse did duck in and Mr. Hernandez quickly corrected the issue, but the damage was done, no penalty to Mr. Hernandez.

Race 7, #1 The Great Oz, ducked in slightly after the start, Apprentice Jockey Slade Jones lost his inside iron but retrieved it quickly. We did speak with him about the run around the far turn where he had to check his mount after sending into a closed spot on the rail and forced #7 out. No placings required.
