Races

Race 1 Reviewed pylons in first turn, no violations.

Race 2 Reviewed pylons in first turn by #1 Best Watch Out (MacDonald) was inside 1, no violations.

Reviewed the stretch, #3 Shadowy (T. Moore) is bearing out, and does allow the winner #5 PL Portia to pass on the inside. No penalty to Moore as the horse is visibly bearing out.

Race 3 Clear

Race 4 Perfect Storm (Lacaille) was inside 3 consecutive pylons after the start. The horse finished last, no placing.

A Black Diamond finished with broken equipment (shoe).

Race 5 Inquiry at the 3/8 pole. #6 Debs New Man (Neill) was inside 2 consecutive pylons, not lapped on at the wire. The horse finished 4th.

Also reviewed the break after the $\frac{3}{4}$ pole by #3 Kingsley B (Sorrie), no violations.

Race 6 Reviewed pylons in the last turn, #4 Phone In (Kelly) was inside 1 pylon, no violation.

Race 7 Reviewed the break before the $\frac{1}{4}$ on #3 Ciona Bromach, interference was given to the trailing horses, no placing needed.

Also #6 Go Daddy Go made a break past the $\frac{1}{4}$ and was pulled up. The horse was examined by the Vet and was put on the long-term list for Lameness. The horse is also placed on the Judges list for performance and must qualify.
