Sahin said his horse was getting in and did the best he could to keep him out. Spooked from something, not sure what but he was getting in. This race was officiated by Sr. Racing Official Fenton Platts and Sr. Racing Official Neil McCoag. Three day suspension was handed to Sahin Civaci.

Review of Race 4 from August 2 with Keveh Nicholls and Rafael Hernandez at the 5/16 pole. Rafael said he was watching Keveh and when he hit his horse and went in, I went out to go around him and that is when he came back out in front of me, caught his heels and went down. Keveh said he kept straight but saw on the video I did go out, it wasn't much.

Review of Race 5 from August 2 with Rafael Hernandez and Leo Salles through the stretch. Leo said he kept coming out, we were running well and he came out on me twice, cost me a position. Rafael said the wind was very strong, I was going out and never expected someone on my outside. I didn't realize how far out we were, the wind was very strong. After discussion it was

decided a three day suspension for Hernandez was warranted.

Race 1 – #1 “Tiz Tap Tango” trained by Tedston Holder arrived at fourteen minutes to post. Tedston said he couldn’t hear the callover the fans in the barn. Advised that post times are published and it is his responsibility to ensure he has his horse to the paddock on time. AGCO rule: 11.01 – Trainer shall have heir horse in the paddock at the time appointed. Tedston was issued a monetary penalty of \$100.00. Race - #5 “Metadata” ridden by Jason Hoyte dwelt at the start but overcame to win.
