Race 1 – Severe weather delayed the race by approximately forty minutes. #1 "Muskoka Lady" was away slow.

Race 2 - #1 "Kaukokaipuu" with Jason Hoyt was away slow. #3 "Trejo" with Simon Husbands was lugging in with the rider throughout and caused interference with #1 at the three sixteenth pole, however, #1 did finish in front of the #3. Spoke with both riders and no action was taken.

Race 3 – The Ruling Angel Stakes – After review of the video, it was apparent that Patrick

Husbands aboard the winner, #4 "Summertime Magic" raised his hand above head while urging his mount through the lane. We discussed the issue with Mr. Husbands and presented him with the video evidence. Mr. Husbands was levied a monetary penalty of \$1,200. for the violation. Ruling #1725695 AGCO rules: 9.27.07(a) and 9.27.08(a)

Race 4 – Clear

Race 5 – Trainer Claim of Foul (COF) by Santino DiPaola who trains #4 "Gav's Dream Girl" ridden by Keveh Nicholls against the #3 "Silent Scarlet" with Justin Stein aboard for interference leaving the gate. Keveh said his horse stumbled first jump but then the horses on both sides came in on me, the #3 especially, I could have won it. Justin said the #4 didn't break with the field and my horse and the #5 filled the gap. I grabbed right away. After review, the COF was disallowed.
