

Video review with Apprentice Jockey Hannah Twomey upon her return from a five day suspension for careless riding. We have witnessed several incidents in which she places herself in unsafe situations on the track and have safety concerns for both herself and her fellow riders. We explained to Hannah that she requires further time and education to enhance her chances of a successful career as a Jockey and therefore we are suspending her Apprentice Jockey license for the remainder of the 2020 racing season. For the 2021 season and prior to re-instatement, we will meet with her and a couple journeymen riders to assess what changes she has made during her time off. AGCO rule: 9.24

Observed Juan Crawford raise his hand above the helmut twice through the stretch on his mount #7 "Be Vewy Vewy Quiet", review with Mr. Crawford set for tomorrow.
