10:30 - Received a call from Trainer Don MacRae who advised that his feed tubs were mixed up this morning and he is unsure if the two horses in today received anything they shouldn't have. doesn't feel comfortable having them compete. Both horses, #3 "Momma Carrie" in the second and #11 "Secret Path" were excused. Mr. MacRae was issued a monetary penalty of \$300.00 for a Stable error resulting in a scratch. AGCO rule: 7.07(i) AGCO ruling #1477484

11:30 – Trainer Robert Gerl was notified that his horse "Arafat" provided a positive analysis for the Class II drug Ostarine following the running the eighth race on October 7, 2021 at Woodbine. "Arafat" is hereby placed on the Stewards list and ineligible to enter or race in the province of Ontario for ninety days, October 20, 2021 through January 17, 2022. AGCO ruling #1476818

#### Film Reviews:

Review of yesterdays second race stretch run involving, Kazushi Kimura, Daisuke Fukumoto and Tony Maragh. Kazushi said his horse was lugging out with him but thought he was clear of Maragh. Daisuke relayed he stayed straight and away from the horse in the middle. Maragh was not present and provided a statement to Guild Exec. Mgr. Daren Gomez to say the inside horse

did come out into his path, he had to check his mount and felt it cost him a position. After review we levied a three-day suspension to Mr. Kimura, days to be determined.

After the sixth race today we held a review with Mr. Flores pertaining to his use of the crop while urging his mount during the stretch run of the second race. Mr. Flores raised his hand above his head several times. Mr. Flores said he didn't feel he was abusing the crop and didn't feel he was above his head until we slowed the video and were able to freeze frame each time he went above his helmet. Mr. Flores was levied a one-day suspension and a monetary penalty of \$300.00
