Follow up meeting with all the riders to set protocol to address safety standards on the racing surface during races. Jockeys Guild Executive Manager Irwin Driedger and a number of riders positioned as Guild Representatives assisted in speaking to the group. This is an effort to work with the Stewards going forward to deal with riders on an individual basis when cited for careless or dangerous riding tactics. Educational reviews will take place after an incident with the Stewards and one or two of the Guild Reps present and any future incidents similar in nature will be dealt with more seriously.

Review of yesterdays seventh race involving Emma-Jayne Wilson, David Moran and Luis Contreras. David said they were all moving together when Emma's horse moves out and into my path, pushed my horse into Luis' horses' hind quarters. Luis said David's horse hit my horse in the back quarter and altering his stride, changed from right to left lead in the process, thought I could have won it. Emma said she used her crop once left handed and her horse reacted, moving out and into David's path, no question I interfered with him but I corrected as quick as I could, however, the damage was done.
