As #10 advances in the third guarter, three other horses move to the outside and #10 ends up fourth-over turning for home. #10 closes in the stretch to finish 2nd. The Panel did not feel Mr. Macdonald was in violation of any driving rules.

Race 4 – Inquiry – Reviewed the start of #9 Tour Champion (Jody Jamieson) for possible broken equipment. The Apex video shows the overcheck of #9 breaks after the start. All horses received a fair start; #9 was charted with BE.
