Race 4 – Reviewed racing going to the half – #9 Dontpokethedragon (Travis Cullen) has room to move off the rail.

Race 5 – #3 Force N Fury (Austin Sorrie) pulled up at the 3/4s and must qualify for Performance. The horse was examined following the race by Dr. Ballinger and placed on the long-term Vets list (lame).

Race 6 – All Clear

- Rick Zeron (#1 Free Willy Hanover) – \$200 monetary penalty and 3-day driving suspension (June 13 – 15) for using more than acceptable wrist action in the stretch. AGCO Rule 22.23.03(b), Ruling #2215783.

Race 7 – All Clear

Race 8 – #5 Southside Eddy (LP Roy) and #9 East End (Tyler Borth) hooked wheels in the stretch, both horses charted with interference. No placings needed.

- Judges spoke to Sylvain Fillion (#8 Sometime Somewhere) about the winner, #6 Jabberwocky (Scott Young), passing along the inside – decision reserved.

Race 9 – Inquiry – Reviewed racing in the stretch between #1 A Boy Named Suuzz (Trevor Henry), #3 Dance Machine (Jonathan Drury) and #5 Private Scott (LP Roy). Utilizing the front tower and apex video, #5 is between horses and appears to keep a straight path. #1 is to the inside of #5 and does not force that horse out into #3. #3 appears to drift in slightly approaching the wire and hits the wheel of #5. #3 was charted with an interference break. The video does not support interference being caused by #1 or #5. No placings were needed.
