Race 7 – Inquiry – Reviewed racing in the stretch between #6 Ima Doll (Tyler Borth) and #8 Sweetest Belle (James Macdonald). The front tower shows where #8 starts drifting down in the stretch and gets her wheel behind the wheel of #6. Macdonald stated his horse was lugging in on him, which made him correct her but didn't get bothered by #6. The Panel did not feel #6 caused interference to #8 and no placings were needed.
